



Foreign Military Members

Eligible NATO and Non-NATO members may now be enrolled in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) database and issued a DD Form 2765, Department of Defense/Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege Card (Machine readable card). This is a sponsor card only and is tan in color. Eligible dependents will be issued the DD Form 1173, United States Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege Card (Machine readable card).

The new DD Form 2765 ID card was implemented with IC 99-1 to AFI 36-3026(I), 29 July 1999.

RAPIDS will automatically assign a Foreign Identification Number (FIN) to foreign military and foreign nationals who are not under the Social Security Administration System and will not receive an SSN.

- In the New Family dialog box select Foreign Identification Number (FIN) as the type of sponsor identifier by clicking on the arrow to the left of the SSN box. Then check Foreign Identification Number, and RAPIDS will automatically default to zeros. At the Add Sponsor Navigator, select Personnel Category of Foreign Military.
- After selection, you'll note RAPIDS has changed the default and assigned a FIN. The number assigned will be a 900 series number; i.e., 900-00-0000. Do NOT enter any other type of identifier. For complete instructions see the RAPIDS Training Guide, December 1998, Section 8, paragraph 8-25.
